  3. No organization or housing unit may employ the use of alumni, outside agencies or non-Simpson students in any part of the scheduled homecoming competition activities. Any organization found to be using any of the above mentioned will be disqualified from ALL homecoming competition activities.
  4. **FRESHMEN RULE.** Freshmen can choose to participate with the housing unit in which they reside or the Greek house which they joined. There will be a NO MANDATORY PARTICIPATION RULE restricting a housing unit or a Greek house to require freshman to participate with them. If the individual's schedule allows, they may participate in both Greek and housing unit or organization activities. No student can participate with more than two groups.
  5. No Judge should be affiliated with the organization on campus.
  6. Everything is in the spirit of competition, and appropriate attitude is required. Inappropriate attitudes may be cause for disqualification or non-participation. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times.

2. Painting shall begin no sooner than Thursday, September 27th.
3. Painting must be completed by 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 2.
4. Judging shall take place Thursday, Oct. 4 at 4:30 p.m.  
**Conversing with judges at this time will lead to disqualification.**
5. Members of a particular housing unit or organization may only paint the board that is designated to that housing unit or organization.
6. There will not be vandalism of other board paintings.
7. A sketching of the painting must be completed and turned in with your entry form.
8. The dimensions of the board must stay the same and nothing protruding from or taken from the board is permitted.

**Failure to comply with rules shall lead to disqualification.**

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# \*SKIT CONTEST\*

4. Time limit will be strictly enforced. Skits should last no longer than **10 MINUTES**. If the 10 minute limit is exceeded, 5 points for each minute or part of a minute exceeding this limit will be deducted.

5. Vulgar language will not be permitted. Skit should be within the bounds of good taste.

JUDGES SHOULD FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

1. The yells should be in the format of cheerleading chants. Singing is not allowed.
2. Absolutely no water may be used.
3. Rehearsal in Hopper Gym only at scheduled times.
4. Vulgar language will not be permitted and will result in disqualification
5. No props will be allowed
6. Yells should be between 3 and 5 minutes. The 5 minute time limit will be strictly enforced. If the time limit is exceeded, a 5 point deduction per each minute or part of a minute in excess will result.
7. For safety considerations, no aerials will be permitted. (i.e. jumping from the railings and body tosses.) Pyramids may only be four levels high.

# \*OLYMPIC ACTIVITIES\*

Thursday, October 4, 2006 - 4:30 p.m.

## Soccer practice field

1. **Tug Of War:** 6 people on each side
2. **Pyramid:** 10 people (4 on bottom, 3, 2 ....)
3. **Egg Toss:** (2 person team)
  - One person blindfolded will toss eggs to partner 10 yards apart
  - Person catching the eggs will be holding a plastic bowl on top of his/her head and will try to catch eggs in bowl
  - Winner will be decided by whoever catches the most eggs in 15 seconds
  - Two teams will compete simultaneously
4. **Obstacle Course:** (5 person team)
  - First person starts @ start/finish line and runs to Station 1

**Station 1 - Bob for apples:** 5 apples in a bucket of water, a plastic flag will be stuck in one of the apples, person must continue to bob until they get the one with the flag; when they do they take the flag and run to station 2, where the next person will be waiting.

**Station 2 - Wheelbarrow Race** - person being "wheel-barrowed" will be blind-folded and guided through 5 cones. Flag will be at end of cones. Blind-folded person must get up, take off blind fold and get flag and pass it to next person

**Station 3 - Piggy Back** Person who "steered" other person in wheelbarrow race will hop on back of person at station 3 will run 15 yards and pass flag to next person

**Station 4 - Dizzy Lizzy** Person will get flag and run to the baseball bats spin 10 times and run back to start/finish line. Two teams will race simultaneously. Winner decided by whoever crosses finish line FIRST.

5. **Pie Eating Contest:**
  - All teams will compete simultaneously
  - Person will have hands behind back
  - First person to clean entire pan is winner
  - It will be up to the judges discrepancy to when your pan is clean.
