The Wesley Service Scholars (WSS) Program supports students who choose to engage in community service as a way to explore the meaning of vocation in their lives. The WSS program honors John Wesley's commitment to the links between spirituality and service. In his words, "true faith cannot be hid but will break out and show itself by good works."

The Wesley Service Scholars Program targets students who are engaged in existing community service experience through the office of the Religious Life Community, Residence Life, Greek Life and/or other related service programs. Any student who is interested in community service and is in good standing with the college is eligible to apply.

Each Wesley Service Scholar will receive a scholarship of \$500 for the academic year (\$250 per semester).

Wesley Service Scholar Requirements

Wesley Service Scholars will complete the following:

at least 80 hours of service each academic year (~ 40 hours each semester);

- will maintain a service journal;
- will read selected common readings;
- will participate in monthly service reflection sessions.
