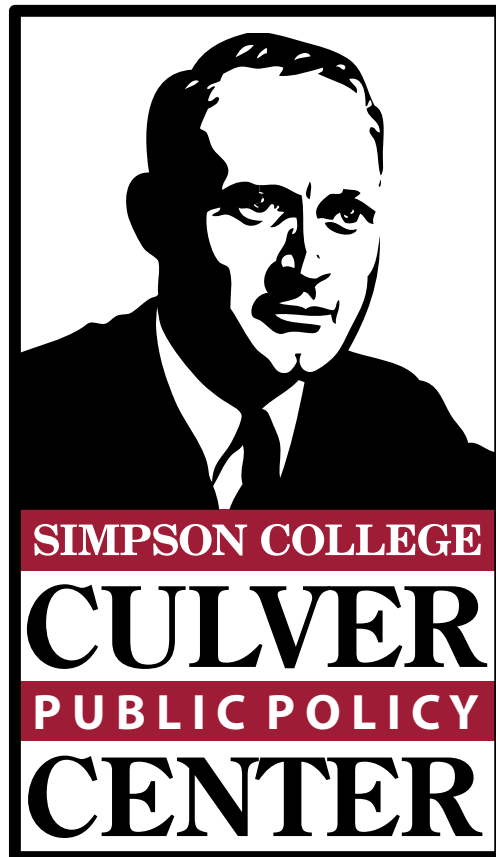

The John C. Culver Fellowship is awarded to students with a passion for politics, history or public service. Culver Fellows will have unique opportunities to pursue a variety of programs sponsored by Simpson College.

Each year, up to five incoming students will be named Culver Fellows and awarded a minimum of \$12,500.

Eligibility Criteria

- New full-time first-year student
- John C. Culver Fellowship application submitted by February 1st
- Strong academic ability as evidenced by high school performance including standardized test scores
- Demonstrated passion for history, politics or public service and potential for leadership
- All candidates for this fellowship must complete the Simpson College application for admission and receive notification of acceptance.

Due to the generous amount of this fellowship, it cannot be combined with other Simpson College merit or talent-based scholarships. Students may, however, be eligible for need-based institutional, state or federal financial assistance.

Preference given to applications received by February 1, 2011.
