

FERPA WAIVER
(Family Education Right to Privacy Act)

By Federal Law, all students 18 years or older have a right to protect the privacy of their academic records. This waiver, if filled out and signed by the student, will give whoever the student has indicated, access to the student's academic records and permission to speak to the faculty instructors of the student about the student's academic performance and progress. The student may rescind this waiver at any time by contacting the Registrar's Office and requesting the FERPA Restricting Grade Report form and submitting that completed form in person at the Registrar's Office.
