Applications must be complete when turned in. Incomplete, invalid, or fraudulent applications will not be accepted. If this application is successful, those named above cannot participate in Room Selection. Signatures are required in all cases except for students currently studying abroad. Signatures represent intent to live on campus and constitute a housing agreement for the following year. Fraudulent applications include signing up for a space knowing that someone on your application intends to live off-campus or withdraw. Students going abroad Fall Semester cannot be on any application. Students not registered full-time for Fall at the end of Spring Semester may have their assigned housing assignment revoked. Only students in apartments and Theme Houses can choose the 6-flex meal plan. The default meal plan for apartments and Theme Houses is 6-flex and for residence halls, 12-flex. General Information:

The lower level of Picken Hall has 4 triple occupancy rooms with a community bathroom. The advantages of this location include 1) having a floor for just you and your friends, and 2) proximity to laundry, pool table, large screen TV, kitchenette, and exercise equipment in the Picken basement lounge.

Each group applying must designate a coordinator through whom Residence Life will communicate directly. A theme or service project is not required, but is encouraged and welcomed.

Timeline and Procedures

Applications are due on Monday, February 4. Please sign up for an interview time when you turn in this application.

Application Interview:

Interviews will take place the week of February 4, and will be coordinated through the group coordinator. *Each group will need to sign up for an interview time when turning in their application.* Each group that applies for the floor in Picken will have a 20 minute interview so that the group can present themselves to answer questions from the selection committee. This committee will consist of staff, faculty, and students. At the interview, the group will also have time to ask questions of the committee.

You may bring as many people from your group to the interview as you desire.
