STORM REWIND: Simpson clinched a berth in the Iowa Conference Men's Soccer Tournament with a 2-1 victory over Dubuque Nov. 1 in Indianola.

The Storm went up 1-0 in the 15th minute when **Lucas Haack** (So., Ankeny, Iowa, Ankeny H.S.) headed in a **Matt Winegard** (Jr., Muscatine, Iowa, Muscatine H.S.) corner kick. Haack made it 2-0 at 81:53 when tapped in a **Corey Miller** (Jr., Sioux City, Iowa, Heelan H.S.) pass. Winegard was credited with an assist on the play as well as it was his throw in that created Miller's passing attempt.

A little under two minutes later Chadwick Newquist scored from the 18 yard mark. Dubuque had one solid scoring chance in the final six minutes, but **Josh Youngman** (Jr., Pella, Iowa, Pella H.S.) made a save on Pablo Martinez's shot.

"I was proud of how the team performed this afternoon," said Simpson head coach Mike Wilson. "Our backs were against the wall and we responded with a great team effort."

Simpson and Dubuque met for the second time in five days in the first round of the Iowa Conference Tournament on Nov. 5 in Dubuque. The Spartans defeated the Storm 3-2 in overtime. Simpson got on the board first when **Chris Allen** (Fr., Reinbeck, Iowa, Gladbrook-Reinbeck H.S.) scored off a Miller assist at 13:37. Christopher Barnas tied the score 17 minutes later.

Haack gave the Storm the lead when he recorded his second goal of the year at the 55:57 mark. Winegard earned the assist on the play. Colin Brice tied the match with 2:01 remaining in regulation. Ski Hill gave the Spartans the victory with a goal 7:11 into the first overtime.

"Obviously, we are all disappointed about the loss," Wilson said. "I am extremely proud of our team as we have made an enormous amount of progress this season. With the graduation of just one senior, I'm confident that we will continue to be a conference contender in 2009."
