

**SIMPSON COLLEGE**  
**STUDY ABROAD AND MAY TERM TRIP REFUND POLICY**  
**Fall 2009 and Spring 2010**

All students' deposits and final payments for "Simpson Experience Abroad" and May Term international travel courses must be considered non-refundable. The program director, on the students' behalf, must pay large advance deposits to third parties for reservations pertinent to the program. Due to the nature of these deposits and the third parties involved, it may be the case that refunds are possible for some programs and not others or that refunds were possible in a prior year but not in the current year for the same program.

To the extent possible, program directors and Simpson College will attempt to secure a partial refund for students who withdraw from the program and the trip director is notified prior to 90 days before the program's departure. The partial refund to the student will be calculated by Simpson on an individual student basis and will only consist of funds that have not been paid to a third party and/or funds that are returned from the third party on behalf of the student. The partial refund will be reduced by reasonable administrative and clerical costs incurred by Simpson College in obtaining refunds from the third parties on behalf of the student.

Due to the shorter nature of the May Term experience and the difficulty in precisely estimating May Term international travel courses' costs, a refund will be given to students for excess funds when the May Term course is completed, all expenditures have been paid, and it is determined that more money was charged to the students for the course than was needed.
