SOCIOLOGY MAJOR

REQUIRED COURSES:

- SOC 101: Intro to Sociology (CE)
- SOC 210: Statistics for the Social Sciences (QR)
- SOC 320: Sociological Theory (HP)
- SOC 321: Methods of Social Research (IL)
- SCJ340: Race and Ethnic Relations OR CJ335: Inequality and Justice (DP)
- SOC 347: Field Experience in Sociology (WC)
- SCJ 352: Standards for Professional Behavior (EV, WC)

ELECTIVES:

- 16 credits (*typically 4 courses*) in Sociology, Human Services, or Anthropology

NOTES:

- At least 8 credits of electives must be at the 300 level
- No more than 12 credits can count in another major/minor
- 4 credits can be from a related area outside of the department, with departmental approval

- 12 credits (*typically 3 courses*) additionally in Sociology, Human Services, or Anthropology
