Immunization Records – Health Services

All students are required to complete the electronic health form and provide proof of immunizations through the electronic health records, Mediat. Log in to the patient portal at simpson.medicatconnect.com using your Simpson username and password (you can also log in through <https://myapps.microsoft.com>). Documentation of religious and medical exemptions will be accepted and should be uploaded to the immunizations form section. Students will need a copy of their immunization records to input the information and upload a picture.
